At 1645 at BS603492 C/C with Bn CO and Bn S-3 aboard rec AK fire w/ neg cas or dam while searching for missing EM. At 1725 MINH LONG SF/CIDG obser 6 VN pers pulling long object out of river at BS603482. An elm of the MINH LONG SF/CIDG was CA'd in to check out and rec heavy SA fire fr BS603482, at this time 4-3 lost radio contact w/ the unit. At day's end the EM fr Co B was still MIA. At 1645 Co A dusted off EM w/ badly cut right hand. There were neg other significant events during the day.
