230 hours; Bunker # 6 spotted 2 VC approximately 50 meters in front of Bunker # 7 (inside of concertina wire), Bunker # 6 received small arms fire and requested permission to return fire. Request granted and fire directed on enemy. Fire returned by VC, flares were then requested and subsequently fired revealing approximately thirteen (13) VC to the right front of bunker # 6 and directly in front of bunker # 7. Enemy fired on with the estimated kill of 3. No confirmation on this.

Bunker # 8 spotted approximately 4-6 VC in front of bunker # 7, enemy engaged by fire after permission received from CP. Enemy headed towards house in woods still returning small arms fire. Not confirmed but it is suspected that the enemy did have one automatic weapon with him.

Bunker # 9 Spotted 4 or 5 VC approximately 75 to 150 meters in front of and towards bunkers # 8 and 9. Enemy engaged by fire with one (1) probable hit. Enemy returned fire (one (1) automatic weapon) on bunker # 9. Enemy then broke contact and headed for house in woods.

015 hours; Trip flare detonated in front of Bunker # 7, illumination revealed (See by bunkers 8 and 9), three (3) flashlights approximately 50-75 meters in front of bunker # 6. Bunkers 8 and nine (9) opened fire and lights were quickly extinguished. At this time bunker # 6 opened up on two (2) enemy personnel who were then running toward the previously mentioned house. Enemy continued to return small arms fire during withdrawal.

230 hours; Bunker # 3 requested flare to illuminate bunker # 4's area, revealing movement. Another flare revealed eight (8) men running across rice paddies located approximately 100 to 150 meters out and 90 degrees to the right of bunker # 4.
