SUBJECT: DESTRUCTION OF ENEMY BOOBY TRAPS

1. (C) IN AN ATTEMPT TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF CASUALTIES DUE TO ENEMY BOOBY TRAPS, IT HAS BEEN PROPOSED THAT CLEARANCE OF AREAS SUSPECTED OF BEING BOOBY TRAPPED MAY BE ACCOMPLISHED BY ATTACHING A LENGTH OF CHAIN BETWEEN TWO TRACKED VEHICLES AND TOWING IT ACROSS THE GROUND IN THE SUSPECTED AREA. THE CHAIN SHOULD DETONATE ANY MINES OR BOOBY TRAPS IN THE AREA IF THE TERRAIN WILL PERMIT SUCH AN OPERATION. THIS TECHNIQUE HAS BEEN SUCCESSFULLY EMPLOYED IN AREAS OF MR 3.

2. (C) US NAVY CHAIN WEIGHING 18 POUNDS PER LINEAR FOOT IS AVAILABLE.

3. (U) REQUEST YOU FORWARD YOUR RECOMMENDATIONS, ATTN: AVDF-BAOP NLT 24 JAN 71 AS TO THE FEASIBILITY OF CONDUCTING SUCH AN OPERATION WITHIN YOUR TAOI.
